# Day 1. Aeropuerto Mérida - City Tour

Reception at Manuel Crescencio Rejón Airport. Transfer to the hotel. Meeting at the Carnavalito offices. Later, we will visit the beautiful "White City," home to some of Yucatán's greatest treasures: the elegant Paseo Montejo, ancient Cathedral, the Regional Museum Anthropology, and the best restaurants to taste cochinita pibil, queso relleno, and papadzules. We will explore the most emblematic points aboard the "Carnavalito" (a typical truck used for city tours). The rest of the afternoon is free. Passengers will return to the hotel on their own. Overnight stay in Mérida.

### Day 2. Mérida - Las Coloradas - Río Lagartos -Mérida

Desayuno en el hotel.

We will begin our journey to Las Coloradas, artificial formations known as "charcas" where salt poured into each one gives tonalities ranging from pink, orange to golden. (Swimming is not allowed as this area is privately owned, and the salt obtained is for commercial purposes. Only photography is permitted. It's essential to note that there is no tourist infrastructure, but a couple of rustic restaurants can be found nearby.)

Later, we will travel to the Ría Lagartos Natural Reserve. Due to the unique geographical features of the Yucatán Peninsula, there are no rivers, but formations with similar characteristics called "Rías." These are channels of water that enter from the sea into the continental coast, forming water vegetation. Here, we will take a boat to explore the biosphere and observe the local fauna, such as alligators, flamingos, herons, and more. Return to Mérida. Overnight stay in Mérida.

#### Mérida - Chichen Itzá- Playa del Day 3. Carmen

Desayuno en el hotel.

We will transfer to the famous ruins of Chichén Itzá, which means "Mouth of the well of the water sorcerers" in the Mayan language. It was the most important city between the years 900 and 1300 of our era. The most famous building is the Kukulcán Temple, also known as "El Castillo," which, along with the Temple of Warriors, the ball court, the astronomical observatory, and the nunnery complex, showcases the ceremonial character of the city. During the spring equinox (March 21) and the autumn equinox (September 21), an effect of light and shadows projects a serpent descending on the northern staircase of the Castillo, symbolizing the mandate to commence agricultural activities before the rainy season.

Afterwards, we will head to Playa del Carmen aboard a bus. (There will be a transfer of vehicles, and the transportation from the terminal to the hotel in Playa del Carmen will be at the passengers' own expense).

Overnight in Playa del Carmen.

## Day 4. Playa del Carmen - Cozumel - El Cielo - Cozumel

Breakfast at the hotel.

Meeting at the pier to take the ferry to Cozumel. In Cozumel, we will head to the pier to take the boat that will take us to El Cielo biosphere. It is known for its various shades of turquoise highlighted by white sand and countless starfish found in the region.

We'll have the opportunity to snorkel and enjoy this stunning natural pool. Afterwards, we will return to Cozumel to take the ferry back to Playa del Carmen. (Transfer to the hotel is at the passengers' own expense). Rest of the afternoon free.

Overnight in Playa del Carmen.
